Medium - Marble

Size - 138 inches

Depiction - Depicts the visions of a spanish nurse
'Saint Teresa of Arila', where an angel pierces her
heart with a fire-tipped spear.

Location - Santa Maria della Vittoria, Rome

Depiction - Depicts the body of Jesus on the lap
of his mother Mary after crucifixion.

Depiction - Portrays Emperor Charlemagne, on

LAOCOÖN AND HIS SONS

27 BC - 68 AD

Sculptor - Agesander, Athenodoros, Polydorus

Medium - Marble

Size - 6.1 ft x 5.4 ft x 3.8 ft

Depiction - Depicts the Trojan priest Laocoon and his sons Antiphantes and Thymbraeus being attacked by sea serpents.

Location - Vatican Museums, Rome





DISCOBOLUS

460 - 450 BC

Sculptor - Myron

Medium - Bronze

Size - 20 inc. x 38 inc. x 68 inc.

Depiction - Depicts a youthful ancient greek athlete throwing discus.

Location - Original was lost but numerous marble copies exist in different places.

Medium - Carrara Marble

Size - 10.5 ft x 3.5 ft x 3.8 ft

Depiction - Depicts the victory of Perseus and
Danae over Medusa.

Location - Garden of Versailles

Sculptor - Auguste Rodin

Medium - Bronze

Size - 73.2 inc.

Depiction - Depicts a nude male sitting on a rock with his chin resting on one hand as though in deep thought.
